

At CONCEPTUAL, our mission is to create and manufacture furniture that brings people together and invites them to cooperate anywhere, anyhow, anytime.

Trans-it is Conceptual's modular toolkit for transition zones in the post-pandemic office environment. With only some 20 modules, touchdown workstations, room dividers and quiet zone lay outs can be endlessly configurated and transformed.

Trans-it - the name says it all:

"Transformation" or the ease with which the product can be remodelled. The modules can be exchanged, supplemented or reconfigured in next to no time.

"**Transit**" because it is specially tailored to the needs of people who are active in office transit zone for a short time, e.g. between 2 meetings.

"**Transition**": The current environmental issues, mobility problems and the recent pandemic make that the world is in transition as never before, with significant effects on the working environment. Trans-it offers a secure and flexible solution for accompanying these changes.

Characteristics

MODULARITY

The clever Trans-it connecting device guarantees a quick, tool-free and foolproof assembly of the panels. In combination with the various table top options, seating modules and accessories, an almost endless combination of configurations can be built.

SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability has been at the top of the list since Trans-it's ideation phase. That is why the materials have been carefully selected. The base frame of the panels is made of wood from ecological forestry (fsc-certified) and formaldehyde-free hdf boards (e1 classification). The acoustic filling is made from recycled textiles. There is an environmentally friendly selection of fabrics available, some with oeko-tex standard 100, eu ecolabel and / or greenguard certification. At the end of life, the fabric covers can be removed and the individual materials can be sorted and disposed in an easy way.

ACOUSTICS


The structure - a combination of partly perforated, partly non-perforated hdf panels with textile filling - guarantees optimal acoustics. Trans-it thus meets high absorption and insulation standards.

CORONA PROOF

The corona virus has presented our industry and the whole world around it with major challenges. Trans-it is designed to overcome some of them. The 140 cm high panel modules provide the necessary hygiene protection at the workplace and thus the security for people to feel comfortable in this environment. Especially when using 100% pet fabrics, the surfaces can easily be disinfected by using alcohol or hydrogen peroxide and the removable covers can be washed at 30°.


QUALITY
